

PATIENT MOVEMENT



Imminent Danger - Danger outweighs the risk of further injury from being moved

Move when **UNABLE TO ASSESS** victim's condition or ability to provide basic life-saving procedures.

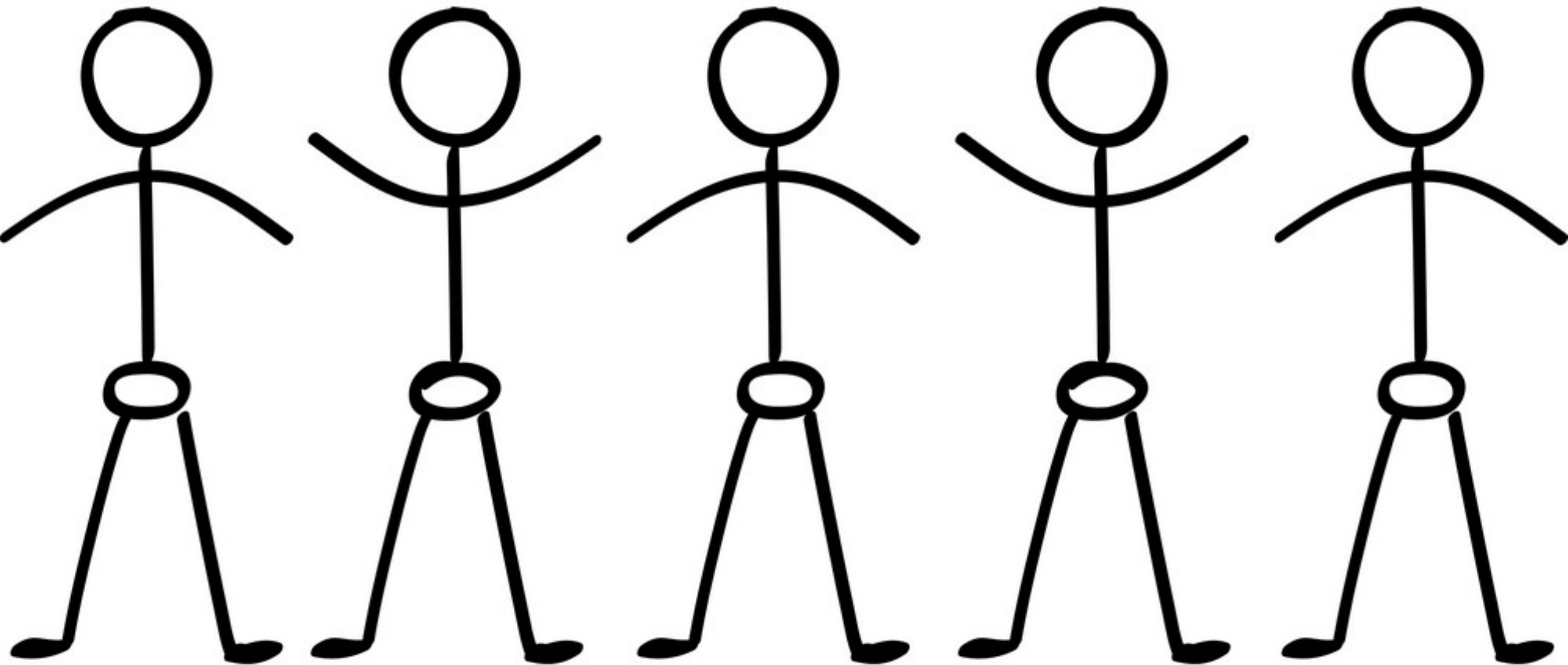
Move victim in a straight line to protect the spine and only as far as you need to to be safe

Never move a victim unless **ABSOLUTELY** necessary

Move them for life threatening reasons
