On July 7, 2006, Natividad Zamano Nunes was driving his vehicle while his blood alcohol level was twice the legal limit. As he rounded a curve, he drifted to the side of the road and overcorrected into the lane of oncoming traffic. Nunes collided with a vehicle filled with a family on route to visit relatives. That vehicle included a father, mother and four sons. Father, Mother and the three oldest sons sustained substantial injuries as a result of the collision including multiple broken bones and lacerations. Their youngest son - 7 months old - was pronounced dead soon after the collision. Nunes was arrested and charged with gross vehicular manslaughter. Nunes posted bail on July 17, 2006, and the judicial process began. On the morning of September 18, 2008, Nunes arrived in court for his scheduled preliminary hearing. When both sides announced that they were ready to proceed to the preliminary hearing, the judge ordered the hearing to begin that same afternoon at 1:30pm and all parties were dismissed for lunch. After lunch, Nunes fled the scene and did not return to the preliminary hearing. A warrant was immediately issued for his arrest and he has not been apprehended.
