On May 17, 2008, Evaristo Jimenez Gonzalez teamed up with his brother, Onesimo Gonzalez Jimenez, and attempted to kill a man who had extended a helping hand to Evaristo's estranged wife. The victim, who lived near Gonzalez and his estranged wife, noticed the woman was having trouble with her vehicle, which was in front of her house and offered to help her. The victim only briefly helped the woman with her car and then left. Evaristo Jimenez, who had partially observed the kind act, became angry. The next day, Evaristo and Onesimo Jimenez knocked on the victim's door while he was sleeping. When the victim awoke and went to open the front door, Evaristo and Onesimo Gonzalez forced their way into his home and began to beat him with a baseball bat. The victim survived but suffered a broken wrist and life threatening head and neck injuries. Onesimo Gonzalez fled the scene and has not been apprehended.
