In late 2008, Corona police detectives began an investigation into lewd acts with a minor. An 11-year-old girl said she had been sexually assaulted by Jesus Reyes, who she knew. During an interview conducted by Child Protective Services, the girl said she had been assaulted by Reyes an estimated 50 times starting when she was about 9 years old. The girl said she often hid when Reyes was around so he wouldn't know she was there. Detectives tried to find and contact Reyes at two different addresses they tracked him to in Santa Ana, Calif. but the people at both places did not recognize or know him. They also tracked down a cell phone number he left at a doctor's office but it was for a pre-paid cell phone.
