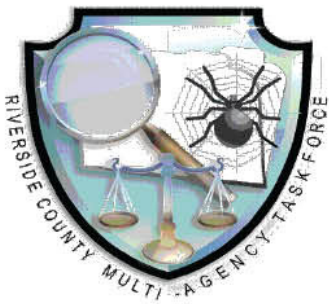

JURUPA SEX OFFENDERS GET VISIT FROM SAFE TASK FORCE, 2 ARRESTED

Riverside, CA – Yesterday, September 8, 2010, investigators with the Riverside County Sexual Assault Felony Enforcement (SAFE) task force, along with the U.S. Marshal's Office, conducted random checks of known registered sex offenders residing within the ZIP Code 92509 in the community of Jurupa. The task force checked 95 addresses of known sex offenders and arrested two people.

Jamie Alan Gresham, 48 was arrested for failure to register and Robert Garcia Sanchez, 57, was arrested for a probation violation and resisting arrest.

The primary objective of this operation was to determine the accuracy of the addresses provided by each registered sex offender. This operation was also intended to impress upon the registrants the necessity of keeping their registration records current and to reinforce that law enforcement officials are actively monitoring their compliance.

During the course of the operation, investigators made face-to-face contact with 94 registered sex offenders at their residences. Four registrants were found to be out of compliance and will be investigated further by members of the SAFE task force. Sixteen parole and 12 probation checks were also conducted during the sweep.

Members of Riverside County's SAFE Task Force routinely partner with law enforcement agencies throughout Riverside County in an effort to keep the community safe from sex predators.
