## TWO MEN ORDERED TO STAND TRIAL FOR MURDER DURING ROBBERY SPREE

MURRIETA – A judge has ordered two San Jacinto men to stand trial for the murder of a 77-year-old man during a crime spree last year in Hemet/San Jacinto area.

Kelvin Leymon Redd Jr, DOB: 4-8-89; and Tiaka Alfred James Mosley, DOB: 7-22-94, are charged with committing a series of robberies in November 2013 in which they targeted elderly and sometimes handicapped victims who were out shopping or dining in the Hemet/San Jacinto area. The defendants are accused of following the victims to their homes and then robbing them at gunpoint in their driveways or garages.

On Nov. 16, 2013, Redd and Mosley are accused of targeting Victor Prinque, 77, and his wife while the couple was shopping at a Stater Bros store on Florida Avenue in Hemet. The two men followed the couple home where Victor Prinque was shot and killed during the robbery.

Redd and Mosley were arrested three days later and have each been charged with the murder of Victor Prinque. The murder count for Redd also contains three special circumstance allegations of lying in wait, murder committed during the commission of a felony, and murder committed during a robbery. Mosley has two special circumstance allegations of murder during the commission of a felony and murder committed during a robbery. Those special circumstance allegations make each man eligible for the death penalty. The decision whether to seek death on either or both men will be made at a later date by District Attorney Paul Zellerbach.

Redd and Mosely also have each been charged with three counts of robbery with sentencing enhancements that the victims were elderly.

At the conclusion of a preliminary hearing held Friday, April 4, 2014, Superior Court Judge Angel Bermudez found there was sufficient evidence for both defendants to stand trial as charged.

Both men are scheduled for information arraignments on April 18, 2014, at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. S204 at the Southwest Justice Center in Murrieta.

The case, SWF1303480, is being prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Daniel Delimon.
